NOTICE OF ANNUAL ELECTION
MOUNT HOPE FIRE DISTRICT

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Annual Election of the Mount Hope Fire District will take place on December 9, 2014, between the hours of 3:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. at the at the Town of Mount Hope Town Hall, 1706 Route 211 West, Otisville, New York, for the following purposes:

To elect one (1) Fire District Commissioner for a five (5) year term commencing January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2019; and

To elect one (1) Fire District Commissioner for a four (4) year term commencing January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2018; and

To elect one (1) Fire District Commissioner for a three (3) year term commencing January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2017; and

To elect one (1) Fire District Commissioner for a two (2) year term commencing January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2016; and

To elect one (1) Fire District Commissioner for a one (1) year term commencing January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2015; and

To election one (1) Fire District Treasurer for a three (3) year term commencing January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2017.

All residents of the Mount Hope Fire District, who are duly registered to vote with the Orange County Board of Elections on or before November 17, 2014 shall be entitled to vote at this election.

Any person desiring to have his or her name appear on the ballot for the office of Commissioner or Treasurer must have filed a written request, specifying the office for which the name should appear, with Helena Grunwald, Mount Hope Fire District Secretary, P.O. Box 854, Otisville, New York 10963, not later than November 19, 2014.

The person receiving the greatest number of votes for the office of Fire Commissioner shall be elected for a term of five years; the person receiving the second highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of four years; the person receiving the third highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of three years; the person receiving the fourth highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of two years and the person receiving the fifth highest number of votes shall be elected for a term of one year. In the event that any persons shall receive the same number of votes the terms of office shall be decided by lot.
